

Domino V120i Printer Information Setting Guide

Introduction

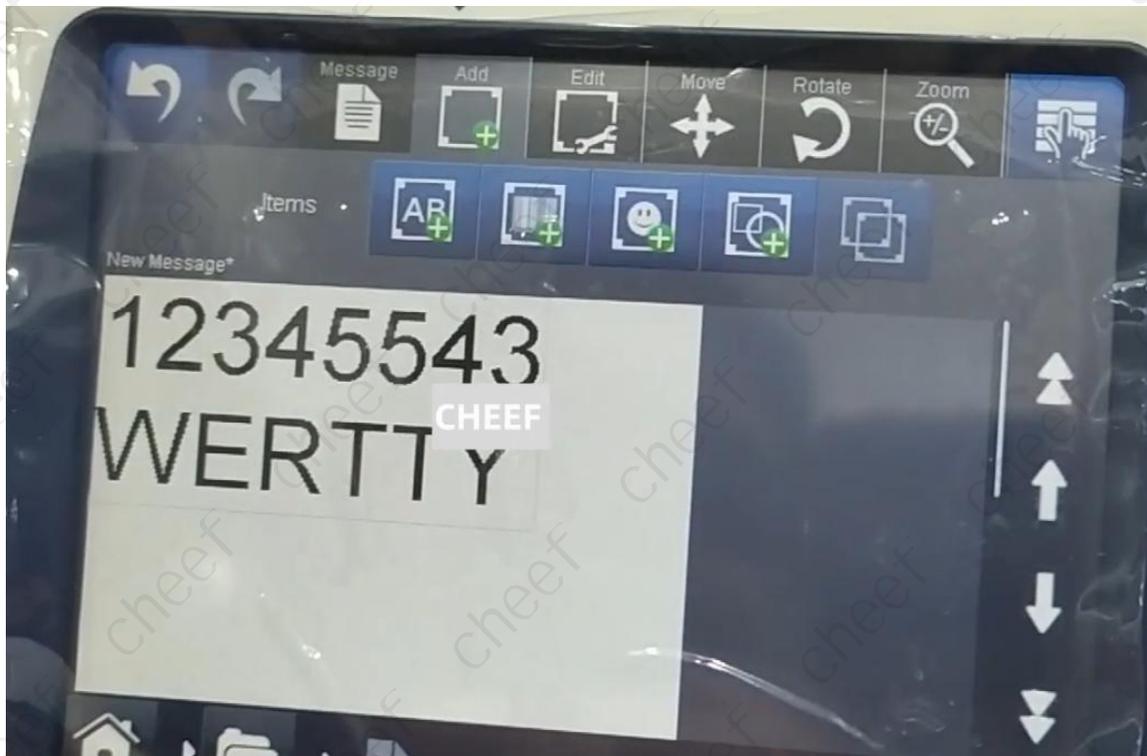
The Domino V120i is a high-performance thermal transfer overprinter (TTO) widely used for labeling flexible packaging in industries such as food, beverage, and pharmaceuticals. This guide, based on the official YouTube video (<https://youtu.be/pjZxRS4JoP4>), provides detailed steps for editing print information (e.g., date, batch number, text) on the Domino V120i, helping users ensure accurate print content that meets production requirements.

1. Preparing for Information Editing

Before editing print information, complete the following preparations:

- ****Check Equipment Status****: Ensure the Domino V120i is powered on and the control panel is functioning properly.
- ****Prepare Print Content****: Determine the information to be printed (e.g., date, batch number, product name) and have the relevant data ready.
- ****Confirm Software Support****: Verify whether editing will be done via the control panel or connected software (e.g., Domino QuickDesign).



2. Accessing the Information Editing Interface

The Domino V120i's control panel offers an intuitive interface for editing information:

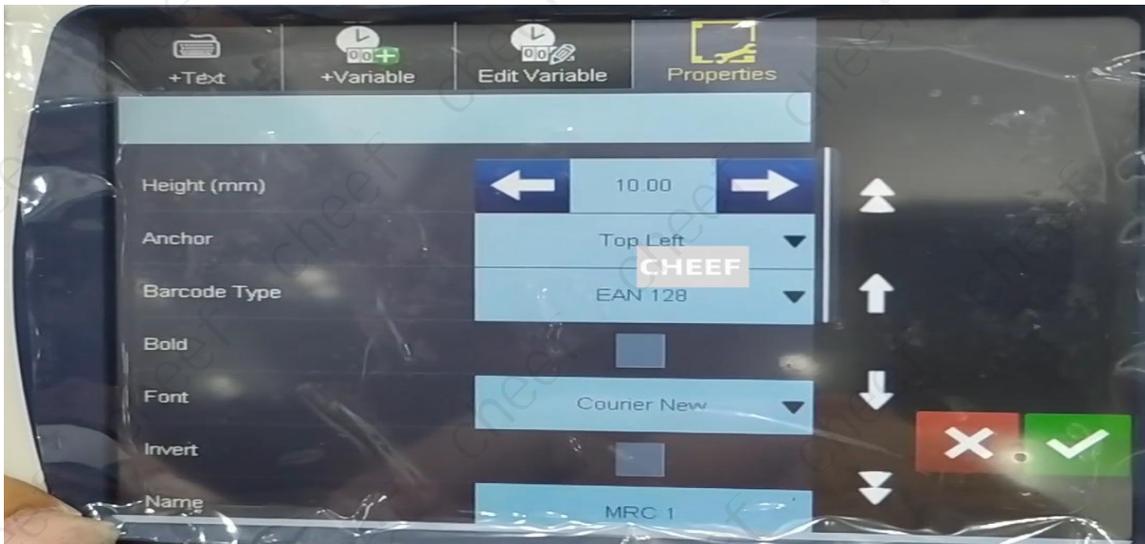
- On the main control panel interface, locate the "Information Settings" or "Print Content" option (typically a text or edit icon).

3. Editing Print Content

Input or modify print content within the editing menu:

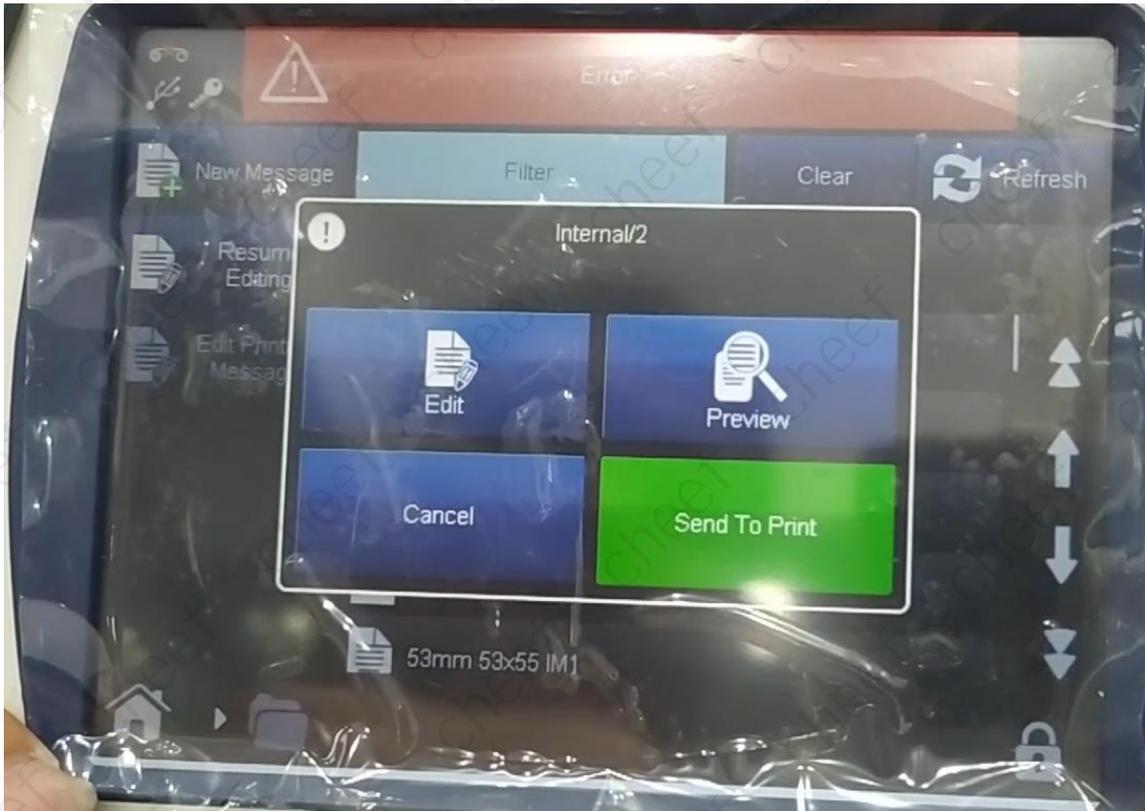
- Select the field to edit (e.g., date, batch number, custom text).

4. Testing and Verification

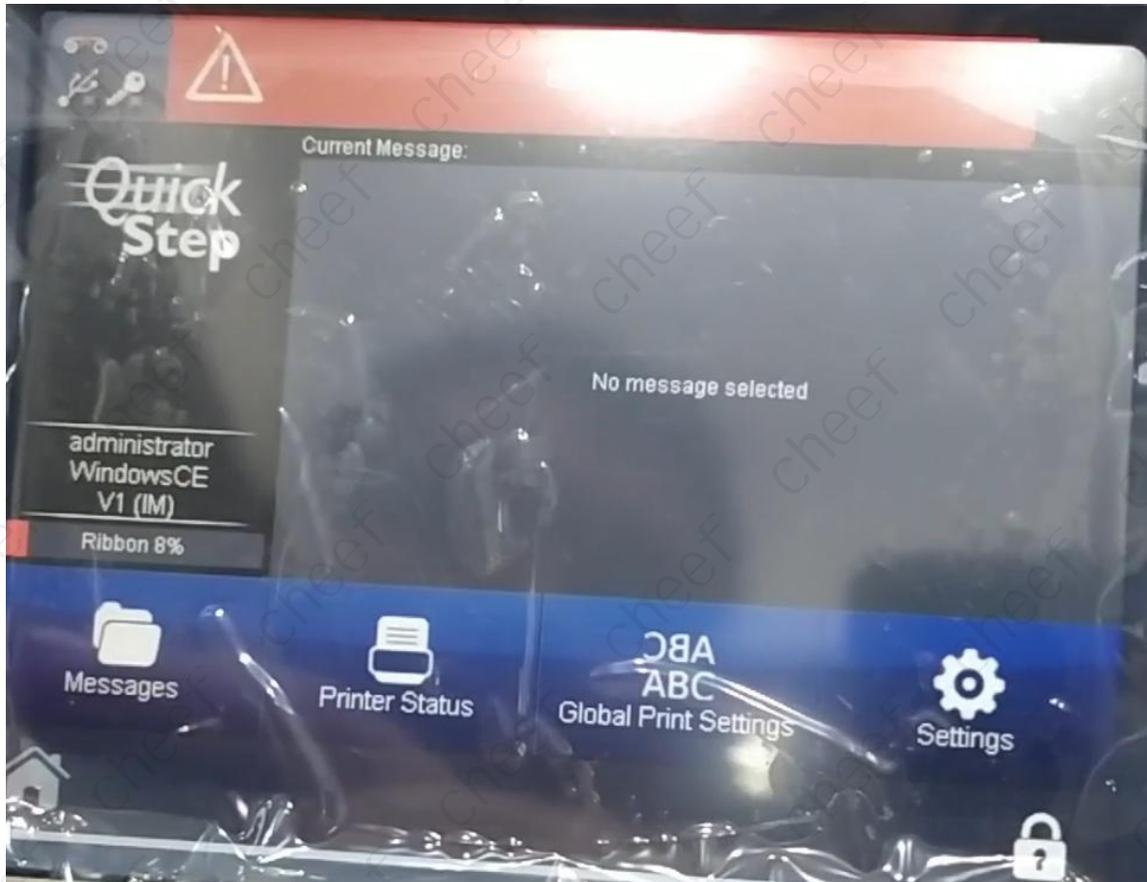
After editing, perform testing and verification:

- If the content is incorrect, return to the editing interface to modify fields or formats.
- Ensure the print content aligns with production needs, such as date format or batch number sequence.



5. Common Issues and Solutions

- ****Incorrect Print Content****: Verify the input data and ensure the correct field template is selected.
- ****Abnormal Print Format****: Check font and format settings; adjust printhead pressure or ribbon tension if necessary.
- ****Unable to Save Settings****: Confirm whether the control panel is locked; refer to the manual for unlocking instructions or restart the device.
